

Roos News – August 2021 – CLUB UPDATE

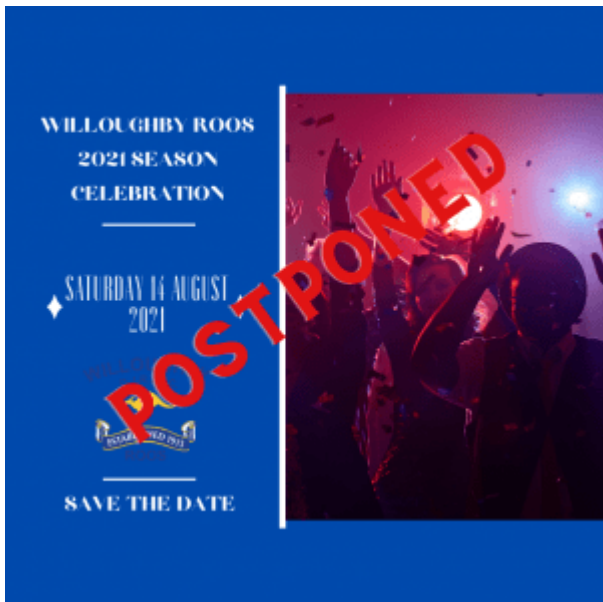
Welcome to Roos News
